Competition, Classes and Participants

Long distance

5 runners per class and country/district

W/M16 50 min

W/M18 60 min

W/M20 70 min

Relay

Each team consists of 6 runners, one from each age classes.

W18 and M18 starts parallel at the same time.

W18 change to M16 and M18 change to W16.

W20 goes out when both W16 and M16 has finished.

W20 change to M20 who takes the team to the finish.

Each country/district can have maximum of 5 teams, mixed and not full teams are allowed to start.



Team competition

Top 3 individual results counts for each class and country/district and the 3 best relay teams are added up to an overall time.

Country/district with the shortest overall time is the winner of the team competition.

Registration and fees

Participating fee for athletes and coaches is 80 euros.

Fee includes:

- Food from friday dinner to sunday lunch.
- Accommodation in houses with 30 beds in each house.
 - Bring your own bed sheets or sleeping bags.
- Model event and competitions.
